## Using your Android with d2u



## Emailing your audio file to us


Select the Voice Recorder app on your Android device. This app is preinstalled to all Android phones and you can record, save and rename dictation files here.











Once your recording has been created and is ready to be typed, press the list button to view your recordings. Press and hold on the desired file for a list of options. Press the 'Share via' button, select the Email icon and email the recording to dictation@dictate2us.com. You will receive an automated confirmation email from our secure system.

## Uploading directly to the d2u website

Android devices support Adobe Flash Player and HTML 5 so you are able to upload audio files directly to our secure website. Use the Voice Recorder app to create a dictation file before logging on to your d2u account and selecting the desired recording. You must have the latest version of Flash Player installed and it is always recommended that you are connected to your Wi-Fi to avoid data charges.
